Re: Request for Opinion

Dear General Abbott:

Article VIII, Section 1-b(h) of the Texas Constitution, adopted in 2003, authorizes "a county, a city or town, or a junior college district" to freeze the total amount of ad valorem taxes imposed on the homesteads of persons with disabilities or persons sixty-five years of age or older.

I would request an Attorney General's opinion as to the following question: May the county commissioners' court, by resolution and vote, call an election of the voters to approve or disapprove such a tax freeze without having first been petitioned to do so by the voters of the county?
