Dear General Abbott:

The purpose of this letter is to request your assistance and opinion regarding the reporting and accounting of charity care provided by non-profit hospitals.

During the 73rd Legislature, I authored SB 427, which required non-profit hospitals to meet one of three standards for providing charity care in return for receiving tax-benefits for their nonprofit status.

Currently there is no enforcement language in the statute, aside from a penalty for late reporting. The reporting section (Sec. 311.0455) of the statute requires non-profit hospitals to submit a report annually to your department. Because your department reviews these reports from nonprofit hospitals that I am requesting your opinion and assistance regarding the charity care provided by these entities. Currently there is a lack of uniformity, transparency, and enforcement in the way in which non-profit hospitals account for their charity care. I would greatly appreciate your assistance and opinion in assessing the current law and recommendations for ways to improve charity care for the State of Texas.
